**Notes to remember**

- In the interests of safety during the trial please ride SLOWLY in or near the car park and ride with caution between sections.
- Wear calf length boots constructed of leather or similar durable material and appropriate riding attire at all times. Approved safety helmets to Australian Standard 1698 (or equivalent) must be worn.
- All motorcycles competing in the event will be subject to an inspection upon arrival at the venue.
- All riders and club officials are to read and sign the indemnity form at the point of entry. Competition Licences must be produced.
- Courtesy is contagious! Please say thank you to the observers, entry taker and other club officials at the conclusion of the event.
- The MAWA Steward is in charge at any event. He/she will be happy to answer any queries and assist wherever possible.
